Normans Music. 32 Well Hall Rd. Eltham SE9 6SF. Open: shop window A music shop which has been in Eltham for over 100 years. Amongst its display of guitars it hosts a fantastic leatherwork guitar strap by artist Zahira al Zahira

SE9 Container Gallery, St Thomas More R C School, Eltham SE9 2SU. Open: Sats 11 - 3pm An unusual gallery in the grounds on St Thomas More Secondary School.
